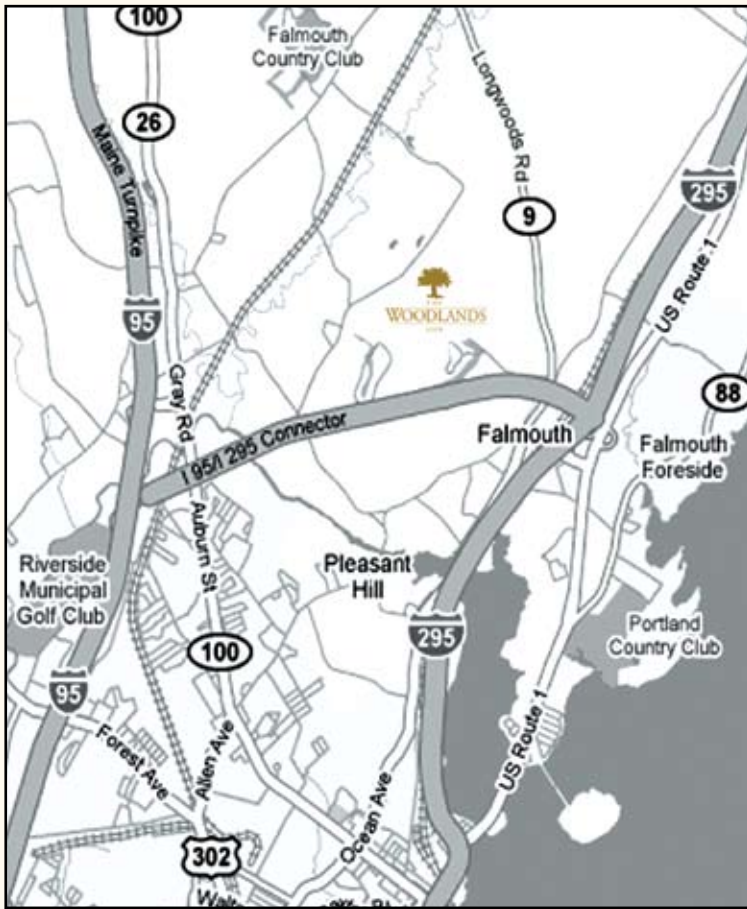

- Take Exit 52
- Follow signs to Route 1 South.
- On Route 1 you will pass the Foreside Tavern. At the stop light, turn right onto Bucknam Road.
- At 2nd traffic light, (Nina's Variety is on the right turn right).
- When you come to a "V" in the road, bear left onto Route 9.
- Take an immediate left onto Woods Road.
- The Woodlands Club entrance is 8/10th of a mile on your left.

From I-295 (North and South):

- Take Bucknam Road exit (Exit 10)
- Turn right off the exit. At 2nd traffic light, (Nina's Variety is on the right) turn right.
- When you come to a "V" in the road, bear left onto Route 9.
- Take an immediate left onto Woods Road.
- The Woodlands Club entrance is 8/10th of a mile on your left.

Wedding Trivia

Why bride on the left and groom on the right? When the groom fought off warriors who also wanted his bride, he would hold onto her with his left hand while fighting them off with his sword in his right hand, (no Southpaws back in those days)!

Why wear a veil? Back in the day, there were arranged marriages, and rarely did the groom get to see the bride ahead of time. After all, if the groom didn't like the bride's looks, he might not agree to the marriage.

Why the third finger of the left hand? As far back as the ancient Romans, there was a belief that the vein in the third finger ran directly to the heart, so the wearing of rings on that finger joined the couples hearts and destinies.

Why wedding cakes? Like any other ritual handed down through the ages, a wedding wouldn't be complete without the fertility symbols, like the cake. Ancient Romans would bake a cake made of wheat or barley and break it over the bride's head as a symbol of her fertility. Over time, it became traditional to stack several cakes atop one another, as tall as possible. The bride and groom were then challenged to kiss over this tower without knocking it over. If they were successful, a lifetime of good fortune was certain for the new couple.

General Contract

*You do not have to be a member to have your wedding at the Woodlands Club

Deposits (*Non-refundable after 30 days of receipt and required to hold date*):

Anticipated Guests:

Up to 25 Guests.....	\$250
26 to 75 Guests.....	\$500
76 to 125 Guests.....	\$750
Over 125 Guests.....	\$1000

This deposit will be deducted from your final bill.

If the patron cancels the function or otherwise terminates the agreement, or the agreement is terminated by the Club, by breach thereof by the patron the Club shall be entitled to retain as liquidated damages the entire amount of such deposit.

Liability: We reserve the right to inspect and control all private functions. Liability for damages to property or equipment will be charged accordingly.

Displays and Decoration: All displays and/or decorations proposed by the patron shall be subject to written approval by the Club in each instance. (Any personal property of the patron's guests or invitees brought onto the premises of the Club and left thereon either prior to, during, or following the event, shall be at the sole risk of the patron and the Club shall not be liable for any loss or damage to any such property for any reason.) The Club is available for your set-up two hours prior to the function. Should you require additional time, prior approval must be attained. Please note the contracted start time is the earliest time your guests may arrive.

Food and Beverage: No food or beverage of any kind is permitted to be brought into the Club by the patron or any of the patron's guests, (excluding wedding cakes, special occasion cakes, party favors and ethnic specialties).

Beverage: We reserve the right to limit and control the amount of alcoholic beverages consumed by the patron's guests. There will be a \$75 bartender's fee to all parties whose liquor sales do not exceed \$250 but did request bar service. All beverage consumption must be done within the designated rented area.

Extra Food: Due to extended liability, food or extra meals cannot be removed from the premises.

Cake Cutting: There will be a \$75 cake-cutting fee for all cakes brought onto the premises. The cake cutting fee will be waived if the cake is served in place of the dessert course.

Guarantee: Menu selections must be made four weeks prior to the function. Catering must be notified no later than 7 days (5 business days) before the event of the exact attendance and final number of selected entrees. This number shall constitute a final guarantee not subject to reduction. Service charges (20%) are applicable to all and beverage charges incurred with the function. (Groups requesting a tax exemption must submit the required forms with the signed contract)

Non performance: If for some reason beyond its control including but not limited to strikes, labor disputes, accidents, government requisitions, restrictions or regulations on travel, Club operation commodities or supplies, acts of war or acts of God, and the Club is unable to perform its obligations under this Agreement, such non-performance shall be excused and the Club may terminate this Agreement without liability of any nature whatsoever upon the return of the patron's deposit. In no event shall the Club be liable for the consequential damages of any nature for any reason whatsoever.
